Governor Huntsman has promised to put kids first. He signed this bill, and has said he will vote for it, because it will help kids who struggle in their assigned school, help reduce class size and increase funding for the kids who stay in their local public school.

And Vouchers are proven to work. Voucher programs exist in many states across the country, and a number of scientific studies have shown that they help improve student and school performance.



Vote FOR putting parents in control and giving families a CHOICE

Moms and Dads know better than anyone else what works best for their child. Not all kids get what they need in their assigned public school. But those kids deserve a good education too. The law provides for a voucher of \$500 to \$3,000 depending on income level. With over 120 private schools and average tuition of less than \$4,000, parents who need an alternative will now have a real option.



Vote FOR smaller class sizes and more funding

Next school year taxpayers will spend more than \$7,500 per student in public schools. The average voucher amount is \$2,000. Consequently, when a student leaves with a voucher, \$5,500 stays in the local school increasing per pupil funding and lowering class size. In addition, the legislature funded the voucher so that no money was taken from public school funds.



Vote FOR HOLDING TAXES DOWN as education costs go up

The Utah Taxpayers' Association endorses Citizen's Referendum #1 because they believe vouchers will keep classes small and keep taxes down. In addition, a Utah State University Study found that a similar program would save the State more than \$1 billion to use in public schools. If we are serious about doing everything we can to help kids, we should vote FOR vouchers. Vote FOR Referendum #1
